Attached are the Bishop's letter and the guidelines re Re-opening of the Church in our Diocese this coming weekend, the Feast of the Trinity. Please read it thoroughly so you know exactly what to do and what's expected from each one of us.

If you or you know of someone in the parish who knows how to make non-medical masks, I was wondering if you could make some for the parish. We want to make them available for parishioners if they think they need them during Mass. It has to be washable so we can use it anytime we need it. And if possible, make it in one color. You may bring it to the office or when you come to Mass. Thank you so much in advance!

We now have 6 Masses on the weekend: **Saturday at 5pm and 7pm; Sunday at 9am, 11am, 5pm and 7pm.** Unfortunately, only Sunday 7pm Mass is available at this time. All the other Masses are already full. Remember, once you sign up for a particular Mass that will be the Mass you will be going to for the whole month of June. You will have to sign up again for the month of July. And if for some reason you are not able to attend the Mass you're assigned, please call the Parish Office so we can accommodate other parishioners and out of town visitors.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available every Saturday from 4:15-5pm on the right side of the main entrance of the church, near Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto.

By the way, when you come to Church for Mass, the usher will assign you to your pew. Because of social distancing rule, you are not allowed to choose a pew.

As we go about re-opening our Church, I ask for your prayers, patience and understanding. May the wisdom of God and his unfathomable love be with us! May our Blessed Mother Mary intercede for us and protect us from this pandemic!
